



## Salander

there's nothing like colorful legwarmers  
to fight a bad mood  
(and the cold too...)



### Size

one fits all : approx 20 cm around and 37 cm length  
- unstretched

### Gauge

20 m/24 rows for 10 cm in stockinette

### Needles

one set of double pointed  
suggested size 3.5 mm

### Yarn

110 gr of PurPle Laines Mérinos SW, here in « *vert émeraude* »  
or 240 meters/260 yards of yarn with corresponding  
gauge

### Notions

eventually a marker

Fun and quick to knit, this pair of legwarmers is not just a fashion accessory, it's also an ally of choice if you are sensitive to the cold.

Knitted in the round, seamless, using some double pointed needles - or a circular one if you prefer to use the magic loop method - with a pretty lace pattern very easy to remember, it's a perfect little project to combine the useful with the pleasant.

## Let's start with the border...

Loosely cast on 50 st, distributing them evenly over the needles. Join to knit in the round (*place a marker for beginning of the round if you're using magic loop*).

First row : \*k1tbl, p1, k2, p1\* repeat from \* to \* until end of row.

Work like this, until you have 5 cm total height.

## ...then the lace part...

The lace pattern is knitted over 4 rows, which are repeated all along the legwarmer.

**row 1** : \*k1tbl, p1, k1, yo, k1, p1\* rep from \*to\* until end of row.

**row 2** : \*k1tbl, p1, k3, p1\* rep from \*to\* until end of row.

**row 3** : \*k1tbl, p1, k3, pass the first st over the other 2, p1\* rep from \* to\* until end of row.

**row 4** : \*k1tbl, p1, k2, p1\* rep from \* to\* until end of row.

Continue, repeating always these 4 rows until approx 32 cm total height.

## ... and finally another border !

Work \*k1tbl, p1, k2, p1\* repeat from \* to \* until end of row.

Continue like this, until you have 5 cm total height.

## A little bit of finishing...

Weave in all ends.

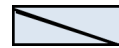
Block eventually with a light shot of steam iron, taking care of placing a towel between the knitting and the iron.

## ...and that's it, enjoy ;)

## Abbreviations

**st** : stitch, stitches  
**r** : row  
**k** : knit  
**p** : purl  
**cm** : centimeters

### ktbl :

knit one through the back of the loop
